

Skip permit

Licence summary

To put a builder's skip on a public road, you need a permit from the London Borough of Bromley.

Eligibility Criteria

No provision in legislation

Application Evaluation Process

Permission may be given subject to conditions which may relate to the following:

- siting the skip
- skip dimensions
- making skips visible to traffic
- care and disposal of skip contents
- lighting and guarding of skips
- skip removal

Will Tacit Consent Apply?

Yes. This means that you will be able to act as though your application is granted if you have not heard from the London Borough of Bromley by the end of the target completion period

No. It is in the public interest that the authority must process your application before it can be granted.
